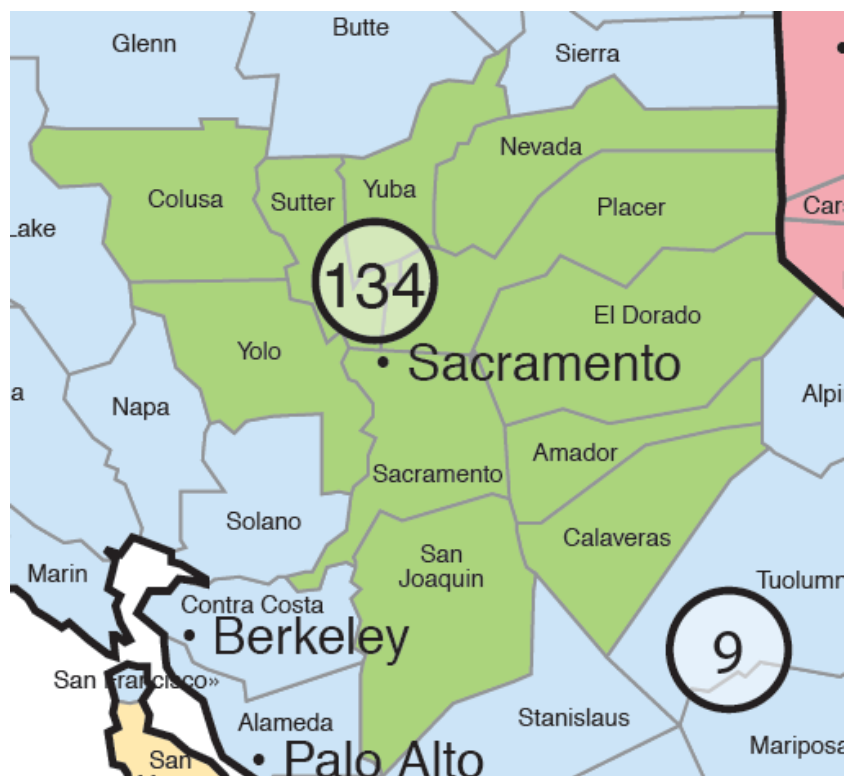


**American Chemical Society Sacramento Section

Purpose: The **Outstanding High School Chemistry Teacher Award** is presented annually to a high school chemistry teacher who has demonstrated an excellent ability to teach and inspire students to pursue careers in science within the Sacramento Section of the American Chemical Society (ACS).
